<sup>1</sup> Design capacity is defined as the original design capacity of the institution, based on industry standards, plus modifications and expansions. It excludes beds and multiple bunking that were instituted to accommodate crowding.

<sup>2</sup> Population counts include inmates physically present at 12:00 A.M. plus reported beds held. This reporting policy applies to all DOC adult inmate facilities and both in- and out-of-state contracted beds.

<sup>3</sup> Midnight Count includes all juvenile offenders under the responsibility (on & off grounds) of each institution at 12:01 A.M. Friday morning.

<sup>4</sup> Total Capacity is a count of every bed in the facility, including security beds. Beds in security are not used to house general population youth.

<sup>5</sup> As of 11/16/2011, John Burke Correctional Center switched from a female to male correctional facility.

<sup>6</sup> As of 12/18/2011, Fox Lake Correctional Facility discontinued its minimum housing and is now all medium security.

Starting 11/16/12, the DJC facilities had been updated. Racine has been removed as there is no longer a SERO Racine Unit.

Northwest Regional Office has been renamed to Madison. Neenah too has been renamed Fox Valley

Starting with Friday, 12/19/2008 the **DOC Friday Report** is prepared using a new multi-level count reporting system. This new system allows better differentiation of inmate categories and locations. Therefore, the report dated 12/19/2008 and all subsequent Friday Reports may show slightly different adult inmate and community corrections " in custody " population trends than previous versions.
