

### Site-Specific Programs in the Wisconsin DOC Psychology Internship – 2014-2015

All prison sites provide evaluations and individual or group psychotherapy. Community Corrections sites provide integrated evaluations (personality, cognitive and projective testing) and individual or group therapy. Community Corrections sites mirror outpatient clinics. The treatments provided for Sex Offending, Anger Reduction, Childhood Trauma, and Domestic Violence Groups are cognitive-behavioral.

Note: the list represents placement locations available to interns for the Fall 2013 semester. Some of the listed locations may not be available for Fall 2014, while others may be added. Changes are due to Supervisor hiring, volunteering, retirement, or choice over time.
