The Department of Corrections (DOC) administers Wisconsin's state prison, community correctional centers, farms and juvenile corrections programs. DOC supervises the custody and discipline of all offenders in order to protect the public. DOC seeks to rehabilitate offenders and reintegrate them into society.

What is VendorNet?

VendorNet provides easy access to a wide variety of information of interest to vendors who wish to provide goods and services to state agencies.

Registered vendors on VendorNet are automatically notified of opportunities in their area of interest.

How and When do I get paid?

Vendors should submit invoice(s) to the primary contact and invoices are paid within 30 days of receipt as required by law. DOC uses both the state purchasing card (P-Card) and checks for payment.
