WRC's resident population includes those serving Wisconsin sentences, Federal sentences, or sentences from another state. It also includes those who have been temporarily confined due to violations of community supervision. WRC also houses other inmates from other jurisdictions, including individuals who are referred for Treat to Competency (TTC) programming from the courts.

At this facility, services are administered by the Department of Health Services in accordance with WI SS 46.056. For budget information at WRC, DHS covers operation costs, which include administration, food, and health care; DOC only covers DOC staff salaries. Offense information is based on each resident's most serious active offense. Residents without a serious active offense are removed from this part of the analysis. The listed percentages may not add up to 100% due to rounding. *As part of Act 19, the 2023-25 biennial budget, WRC staff were moved from DOC to DHS. † Includes mild to serious
