² Population counts include inmates physically present at 12:00 A.M. plus reported beds held. This reporting policy applies to all DOC adult inmate facilities and both in- and out-of-state contracted beds.

³ Midnight Count includes all juvenile offenders under the responsibility (on & off grounds) of each institution at 12:01 A.M. Friday morning.

⁴ Total Capacity is a count of every bed in the facility, including security beds. Beds in security are not used to house general population youth.

⁵ Population includes youth who are AWOL, youth who are being supervised in other states, and DJC youth that are currently in an Adult Facility.
