<sup>3</sup> Midnight Count includes all juvenile Persons in Our Care (on & off grounds) for each institution at 12:01 A.M. Friday morning.

<sup>4</sup> Total Capacity is a count of every bed in the facility, including security beds. Beds in security are not used to house general population youth.

<sup>5</sup> Population includes youth who are AWOL, youth who are being supervised in other states, and DJC youth that are currently in an Adult Facility.
