PROCEDURE**I. Social Security**

- A. Inmates incarcerated for a felony conviction are not eligible to receive Social Security benefits.

- B. An automated weekly interface extracts any changes to inmate records from WICS, including both current admissions and releases.
 - C. The local Social Security Office Manager must be contacted if a Social Security check is received at a facility.
- II. Veterans Benefits**
- A. Inmates receiving VA benefits shall be advised to contact the VA of their incarceration.
 - B. Deductions from VA checks shall not be taken.
- III. Federal and state tax returns shall be processed per DAI Policy 300.00.02 and DAI Policy 309.04.01.**
- IV. Any checks other than tax returns from federal, state or county funds shall be verified by contacting the issuing agency.**
- V. A DOC-243 shall be completed for any funds not deposited into the inmate's account and returned to the sender.**
