DEFINITIONS, ACRONYMS AND FORMS**PROCEDURE****I. General Guidelines**

- A. The Bureau of Health Services Medical Director determines the medical necessity and/or timing of screenings and other preventive services (e.g., mammograms, colorectal screening, prostate screening, PAP smears)
- B. The Bureau of Health Services Medical Director determines the frequency and content of period health assessments.
- C. The Bureau of Health Service Dental Director determines the frequency and content of periodic dental evaluations.
- D. The Bureau of Health Services Medical Director determines the medical necessity and/or timing of screening for communicable diseases (HIV, syphilis, gonorrhea, chlamydia), to include laboratory confirmation, treatment, and follow-up as clinically indicated.
- E. Immunizations are administered to patients as clinically indicated.

II. Periodic Health Assessments and Examinations

- A. The Bureau of Health Services follows recommendations for screening examinations and laboratory testing based on community standards following the U.S. Preventative Services Task Force.

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B. The Bureau of Health Services Medical Director shall determine the content and timing of screenings for patients based on age and risk factors.

III. Immunizations

A. Follow policy 500.60.04 Immunization Policy for Immunization program.

B. All patients shall be offered an influenza vaccine.
