Subject: Mental Health Treatment Plans

#### **POLICY**

The Division of Adult Institutions shall ensure that mental health staff develop and implement mental health treatment plans for every inmate who requires mental health services.

#### **DEFINITIONS, ACRONYMS AND FORMS**

DOC - Department of Corrections

<u>Healthcare Record</u> – DOC-approved electronic medical record (EMR)

<u>HSU Staff</u> – Employees classified as HSU Manager, Psychiatrist, Physician, Physician Assistant, Pharmacist, Dentist, Nurse Practitioner, Optometrist, Registered Nurse, Licensed Practical Nurse, Physical Therapist, Radiologic Technician, or any other clinical classification that is directly supervised by Health Services.

Health Care Staff - PSU staff, HSU staff and Psychiatrists.

Mental Health Staff – PSU staff and DOC Psychiatrists.

<u>PSU</u> – Psychological Services Unit

<u>PSU Staff</u> – Employees classified as Psychologist Supervisor, Psychologist-Licensed, Psychological Associate A or B, Crisis Intervention Worker, Psychological Services Assistant, Clinical Social Worker, or any other clinical classification that is directly supervised by Psychological Services.

<u>Treatment Plan</u> – A series of written statements specifying an inmate's particular course of care, treatment or monitoring and the roles of health care staff in carrying it out.

#### **PROCEDURE**

I. Treatment Plan Development

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Chapter: 500 Health Services				
Subject: Mental Health Tr	eatment Plans			

- A. PSU staff shall develop psychological treatment plans at the time of the intake mental health screening and document within the healthcare record.
- B. PSU staff shall periodically update treatment plans and document within the healthcare record.
- C. Psychiatry staff shall develop psychiatric treatment plans at the initial psychiatric visit and document within the healthcare record.
- D. Psychiatry staff shall update psychiatric treatment plans during all subsequent visits and document within the healthcare record.
- E. Mental health staff may document formal treatment plans within the healthcare record for inmates who have difficult or complex conditions or when a higher level of inter-disciplinary coordination is needed.
