

The juvenile corrections study committee shall study and develop recommendations for the location of Type 1 juvenile correctional facilities ...



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2017 Wisconsin Act 185

Section 110. Nonstatutory Provisions (6)(c)2:

The juvenile corrections study committee shall study and develop recommendations for the location of Type 1 juvenile correctional facilities under section 301.16 (1w) (a) of the statutes based on space and security needs, cost, proximity to the populations of juveniles the facilities would serve, and best practices for holding juveniles in secure custody.

In developing these recommendations, the committee shall conduct an inventory of existing state-owned facilities that have the capacity be used as Type 1 juvenile correctional facilities and shall favor the use of existing facilities.


The committee shall submit to the department of corrections its recommendations for these facilities no later than November 1, 2018.


