

# *Youth Justice System*

## *By the Numbers*

- 518,263 Youth Between 10 and 16 Years Old in Wisconsin
  - 2016 Data. *Puzzanchera, C., Sladky, A., and Kang, W. (2017). :Easy Access to Juvenile Populations: 1990-2016.*
- 39,825 Juvenile Arrests in Wisconsin
  - 2017 Data. *Wisconsin Uniform Crime Reporting data, as reported in the 2018 KidsCount data book.*
- 3,829 Delinquency Adjudications
  - 2017 Data from *Wisconsin Circuit Court Access.*
- 162 New Youth Committed to Juvenile Corrections
  - 2017 Data from *WI DOC.*

# Wisconsin's Youth Justice and Juvenile Corrections System



**KEY**

- Services provided by counties, schools, community-based organizations, etc.
- County provided community services (DCF oversight)
- Correctional placement (State or County)
