1. System-Level – Placements

How can the Youth Justice system best promote the most appropriate placements of youth?

Possible considerations:

- What strategies or requirements can be employed to avoid placing youth who do not pose a public safety risk in confined settings ("widening the net")?
- For youth who are appropriately placed in confined settings, what factors should be considered in determining which placement (SRCCs, Type 1, MJTC) will best meet their needs?
- How can these processes be designed to promote a continuum of care (and not create instability for youth or fragmentation of services)?
- What should happen at original disposition? What should happen at change of placement?

2. SRCC - Programming and Services

What requirements for programming and services should be included in SRCC administrative code?

Possible considerations:

- Consider treatment programs, health care, mental health, education, and recreation.
- Is there an interest in having SRCCs specialize in specific types of programming and services, or is geographic proximity more important?
- What is the appropriate balance between allowing for flexibility but promoting sufficiently high standards?

3. SRCC – Other Administrative Code Requirements

In addition to programming and services, what requirements should be included in administrative code?

Possible considerations:

- Consider physical design, staffing, training, food service, security, discipline, property, etc.
- What is the appropriate balance between allowing for flexibility but promoting high standards?

4. SRCC Grant Applications

Please provide input on the SRCC grant application process.

Possible considerations:

- What information should be required in the SRCC grant applications?
- What factors should the Grant Committee consider in determining which applications to approve?

5. Type 1 Facilities – Location

What factors should be considered in determining the locations and capacities of Type 1 facilities?

Possible considerations:

- How much importance should be given to being near the majority of youths' committing counties versus accessibility throughout the state?
- How can capacities be designed to meet the current and future needs of the population?

6. Type 1 Facilities – Programming and Services

What programming and services should be provided at the DOC Type 1 facilities?

Possible considerations:

- How should the programming and services be similar to or different from that of the SRCCs?
- What staffing levels and training will best support the appropriate programming and services?
- What physical structure and design (other than location) will best support the appropriate programming and services?

7. Data Collection

What data should be collected and reported by SRCCs and Type 1 facilities?

Possible considerations:

- What requirements for uniform data collection should be included in the SRCC administrative code?
- What data should be collected and reported by Type 1 facilities?
- How can data be made more useful for stakeholders throughout the system?
