 - #2024-70, Oct. 14, 2024, DOA Bureau of Human Resources Region 2, Dodge Correctional Institution

BIRT discussed the incident. Goldade moved to find the breach incident risk "low" with no further action. Marik seconded the motion and it passed unanimously. No formal recommendations.

• #2024-71, Oct. 14, 2024, Region 3, Division of Community Corrections

Eggert discussed incident. Stolen phone and confirmed BTM security protocols have been set up to prevent breach. Incident closed with no further action.

• #2024-72, Oct. 21, 2024, DOA Bureau of Human Resources Region 2, Kettle Moraine Correctional Institution

BIRT discussed the incident. Eggert moved to find that the breach incident risk can't be determined until BIRT receives more information on how the disclosure could be used; however, she recommended BHR notification to the affected individual. She also recommended BHR work with the individual, DOA and ETF to determine what if any follow up security measures are needed. Marik seconded the motion; motion passed unanimously.
