Beginning July 20, 2026, FLCI will begin a large project to update the FLCI Visiting Room, as well as the exterior area around the Administration Building. This project will take approximately 12 months to complete. Given the scope and scale of the project, activities in the Administration Building, specifically in-person visiting, will be impacted.

We recognize the importance of visiting and are committed to maintaining a quality environment for visiting during the construction project. For the duration of this project, visits will be relocated to the first floor of the Administration Building. Family and friends coming to FLCI for visits will need to be aware of the following:

- All visitors will be entering the Administration Building through the north door of the building. Signage will be in place and lobby staff will offer directions during processing.
- Visiting hours, sign up procedures, and visiting opportunities will remain unchanged.
- Due to the limited space available, there will be a reduction in vending machine offerings and microwaves will not be available.
- Visiting photos will not be available during this project.
- Visitors should be observant and attentive of moving vehicles and construction equipment near and around the Administration Building.
