RE: Temporary suspension of in-person visits to Persons in Our Care (PIOC)

Effective January 13, 2022, the Wisconsin Department of Corrections (DOC) is temporarily suspending all in-person visits to Persons in Our Care across all adult institutions.

Video visits will continue to be offered.

This precaution is being taken due to the sharply rising positive cases in this wave of the COVID-19 Omicron variant. Making this temporary change will help protect those in our care, our staff, and the communities surrounding DOC's institutions from illness.

You can continue to schedule ZOOM visits by emailing:

Specify a "Zoom visit" in your email, and list two or three preferred dates/times for the Zoom visit. One video Zoom visit (approximately 55-minutes in length) will be allowed per PIOC per week as time and space permit.

General population visiting days/hours for Zoom visits are:

- Tuesday through Friday: 2:45 p.m. – 8:45 p.m.
- Saturday and Sunday: 8:15 a.m. – 3:45 p.m.
- Holidays: 8:15 a.m. – 3:45 p.m.
