POLICY

Division of Adult Institution facilities shall offer HIV testing upon admission to a facility and every six months upon request or when a patient has a significant exposure incident.

PROCEDURES

l. General Guidelines

- A. All patients upon DAI admission, annually and/or as needed, shall be provided education regarding HIV testing. A written declination shall be documented if the test is declined on DOC-3263 HIV Antibody Testing Information and Declination.
- B. At the annual health maintenance, staff shall educate the patient they may request HIV testing at six month intervals while in a DOC facility or anytime following a significant exposure.
- C. HIV testing shall be completed through WSLH.
- D. An ACP order is required.
- E. The patient shall be notified in person by an ACP of positive test results and the ACP shall document notification in the health record.
- F. A written notice may be sent if the results are negative. Patients shall be provided an opportunity to speak directly with a health care provider upon their request. A copayment shall not be charged for this appointment.
- G. HIV testing and results are confidential.
