## **Pregnancy & Childbirth**

Revised 4/5/23

Upon intake all female Person(s) in our Care (PIOC) are given a pregnancy test to determine status. **PIOC**who are found to be pregnant will be evaluated by HSU for any appropriate restrictions. HSU staff will complete forms notifying the appropriate individuals within the institution of the **PIOC** status.

PIOC have the option/right to collect breast milk, refer to DAI Policy 900.50.24 Breast Milk Collection and Storage for further information.

## Social Worker/Treatment Specialist Responsibilities:

Upon receiving notice from HSU, the Social Worker/Treatment Specialist will interview the **PIOC** regarding intended placement of the child upon birth and review the following:

- The Social Worker/Treatment Specialist will inform the Department of Social Services in the guardian's county of residence to identify any concerning matters.
  - If the first placement is found to be inappropriate, other placement options will be evaluated ie Adoption Agency
- Once placement is verified by the Social Worker/Treatment Specialist, the PIOC completes form DOC-1498 Newborn Placement by the DOC Social Worker/Treatment Specialist.
- The Social Worker/Treatment Specialist will forward DOC-1498 to the assigned Social Worker on the designated Community Hospital Maternity Unit
- After the birth of the child, visitation with the guardian and child may be approved by completing a special visit using DOC 1115 Special Extended Visit and DOC 1115A Special Extended Visit Notice to Inmate Youth.
  - Social Worker/Treatment Specialist shall encourage the PIOC to get the child on visiting list as soon as possible by sending the child's legal nonincarcerated guardian/custodial parent a DOC-21AA Visitor Questionnaire.
