

WI Program Selected Reporting Data Areas Definitions

- Qualified and Screened by DAI, DCC, and Total. This shows the total number of offenders who were screened and deemed eligible for the Vivitrol program prior to being invited to participate or undergoing the required medical screening, either during the 6 months prior to release from a DAI facility or for an offender coming directly from the community for active probation supervision.
 - The criteria for being considered eligible are as follows, with some exceptions permitted on a case by case basis upon review by Agent of Record (AOR), Corrections Field Supervisor (CFS), and ultimately the Region's Program and Policy Analyst (PPA).

- DAI Qualified subset showing Volunteered and Declined to Volunteer. The total of these would be the same number as the total Qualified and Screened by DAI above.
- Volunteered in DAI subset showing current status including:
 - Currently active in program
 - On hold from program
 - Ended program (but not as a successful completion)
 - Failed preliminary medical screen (meaning they never started the program)
 - Successfully completed the program (either to date or since prior report or both)
 - Total of this subset is the same as DAI Qualified and Volunteered above
- DCC Qualified. Same as DAI Qualified showing subset for Volunteered and Declined to Volunteer, only these people did not come directly from DAI.
- Volunteered in DCC subset showing current status including:
 - Currently active in program
 - On hold from program
 - Ended program (but not as a successful completion)
 - Agreed but failed preliminary medical screen (meaning they never started the program)
 - Successfully completed the program (either to date or since prior report or both)
 - Agreed but absconded (never started)
 - Agreed but discharged (never started)
 - Agreed but incarcerated (never started)
 - Agreed but revoked (never started)
 - Agreed but self-terminated (never started)
 - Completed the program (either to date or since prior report or both)
 - Total of this subset is the same as DCC Qualified and Volunteered above.
- Volunteered in DCC distribution by end reasons:
 - Ended-Absconded
 - Ended-Discharged (No DOC Custody or Control)
 - Ended-Medical
 - Ended-Moved (moved out of DCC Region 4)
 - Ended-Other (which as of last report included only cost, new sentence, and going to private pay)
 - Total of this subset is the same as DCC Qualified and Volunteered and Ended Program above.
- Participants with at least one shot from DAI, DCC and Total. These are a subset of Qualified and Volunteered in DAI and DCC. This Total becomes what we know as Pilot Participation.
- Pilot Participation subset distributed by Active, Ended Program (but not as a successful completion), Successfully Completed Program, On Hold, and Total. This Total is the same as Participants with at least one shot from DAI, DCC above.
- Current Participants by Gender currently recorded as Female or Male, and Total. This Total is the same number as Active in the Pilot Participation above, as well as the Total of Qualified and Volunteered and Active for DAI and for DCC above.
- Current Participants by Age. This Total should be the same as Total for Current Participants by Gender. Age reported in the following groups:
